The AspirinWorks® Test Kit received clearance in May 2007 by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration for in vitro diagnostic use in the United States. The AspirinWorks® Test is an enzyme-linked immunoassay (ELISA) to determine levels of 11-Dehydro Thromboxane B2 (11dhTxB2) in human urine, which aids in the qualitative detection of aspirin effect in apparently healthy individuals post ingestion. Unlike other tests, which require freshly drawn blood that must be evaluated within at least four hours, the AspirinWorks® Test requires a urine sample that can easily be obtained in any doctor's office.

The AspirinWorks® Test measures the effect of aspirin on platelets through direct measurement of thromboxane production (aspirin's target). The stickier the blood platelets, the less impact the aspirin is having.
